The program offers career and financial counselling, as well as the opportunity to apply for a loan of up to \$10,000, to help with the costs associated with gaining employment in a profession or trade. ## **Manitoba Student Aid**

Manitoba Student Aid is a supplemental financial assistance program for Manitobans who do not have sufficient resources to pay for their post-secondary education on their own. They provide various types of funding on behalf of the Manitoba Student Aid Program and the Canada Student Loans and Grants Programs. This funding includes repayable government student loans and non-repayable grants and/or bursaries. All applications are assessed to determine eligibility and financial need.
